Stories of Impact

These are our neighbors. They just happen to be houseless.

The homeless outreach program at UnityPoint Health – Meriter, Helping Educate and Link the Homeless (HEALTH), helps those without a home receive care for both acute and chronic medical conditions. When individuals are focused each day on finding food, water, warmth, rest and security, health care is difficult to attain. That's why the dedicated teams at HEALTH practice a grassroots approach, meeting individuals where they are: in shelter and on the street.

During one of these visits, the HEALTH team was introduced to a gentleman living in a tent behind a grocery store in Madison. Suffering from alcohol addiction, he was frequently in and out of treatment for severe withdrawals. After earning his trust, the HEALTH team was able to connect him with the addiction services he needed to reach sobriety. He's been sober for several years and housed for three years. With his healthcare needs and housing insecurity addressed, he has remained employed and has saved enough money that he's looking at purchasing a home soon.

"It is because of them that I have a future."

"It was [at UnityPoint Health – Meriter Child & Adolescent Psychiatry] that I finally felt understood and learned that I didn't have to go through [this mental health crisis] alone. I learned how to control my mental health in a way where it wasn't so debilitating... It is because of them that I have a future.

They led me through the dark tunnel until I was eventually able to see the light, and for that, I am forever grateful ... There are not enough words to express my love and appreciation for what they have done for my family and I. Thank you!"
